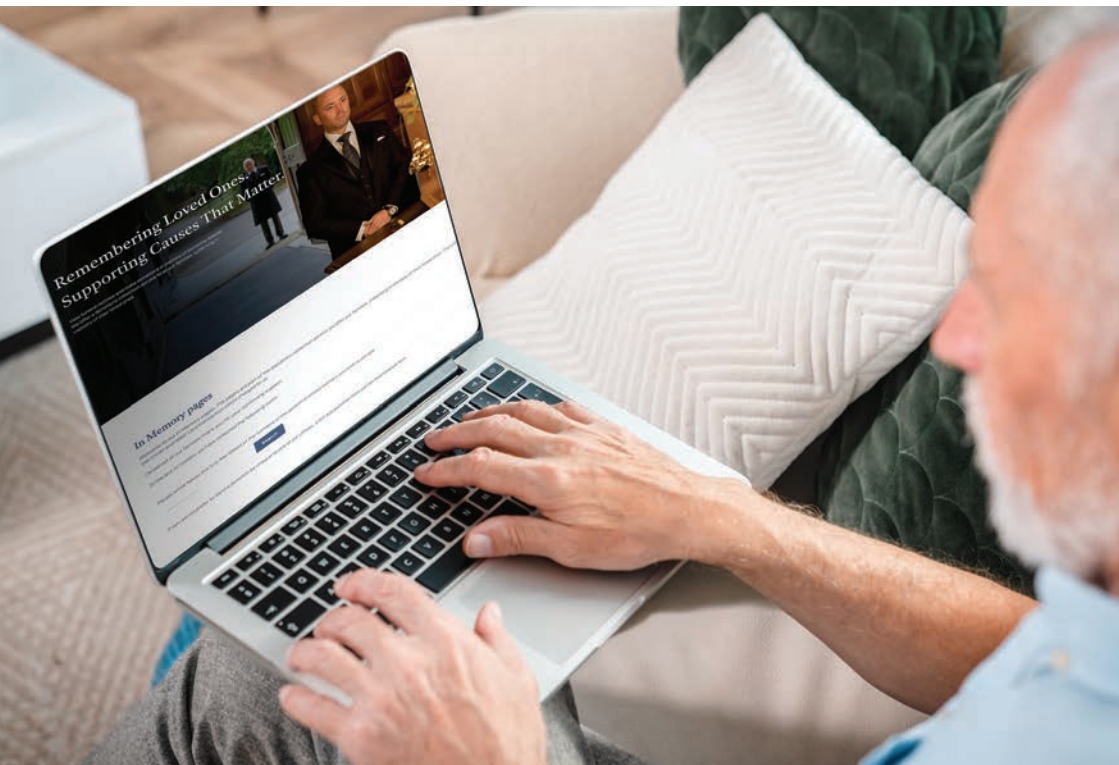
Recording

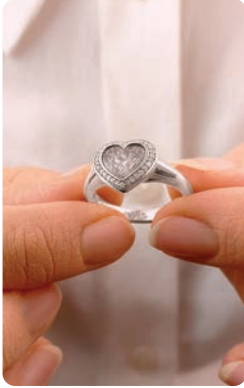

Help with Funeral Payment

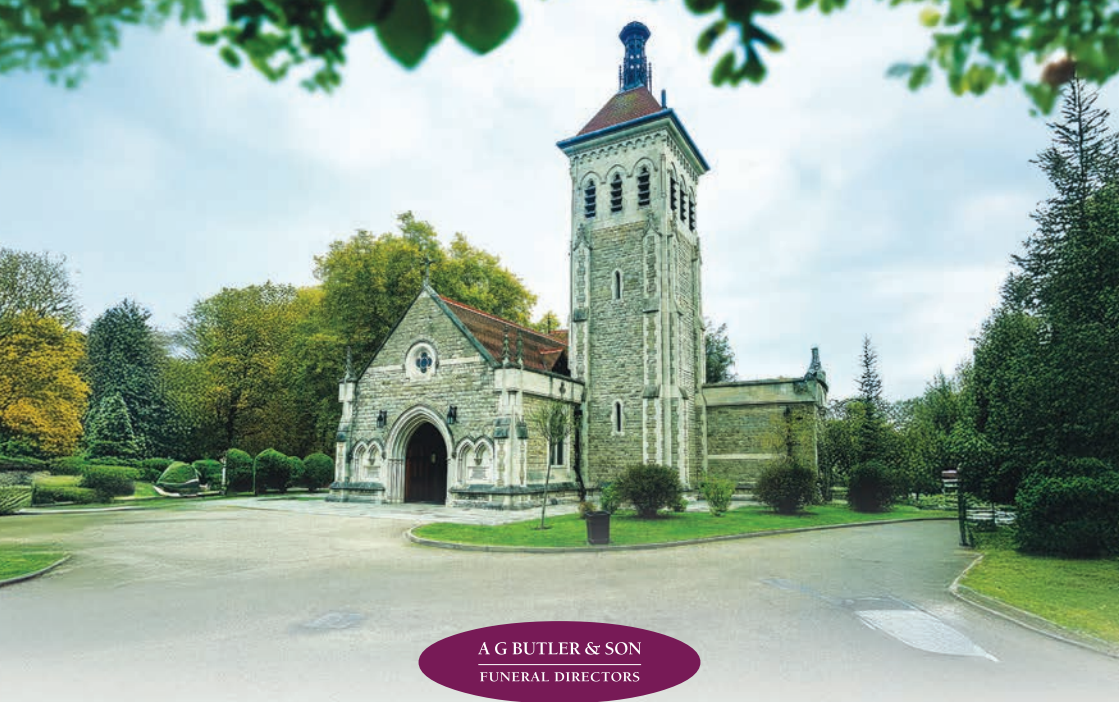
The UK government offers financial help with funeral costs through a Funeral Expenses Payment (in England, Wales, and Northern Ireland) or a Funeral Support Payment (in Scotland) for those on certain benefits. The amount depends on your circumstances, but the payment can help with costs like burial fees, cremation fees, and funeral director's fees, with up to £1,000 available for funeral expenses.
